2 Education – High School Teachers Teaching Dual Enrollment Courses – 3 Qualifications

FOR the purpose of requiring certain county boards of education to allow a high school teacher to teach a dual enrollment course offered by an institution of higher education if the teacher meets certain criteria; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the qualifications of high school teachers teaching dual enrollment courses offered by institutions of higher education.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

 - 17 **6–124.**

18 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "COLLEGE–LEVEL COURSE" MEANS A COURSE OR A 19 SEQUENCE OF COURSES THAT:

20 (1) CONSTITUTES PART OF THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE 21 DIPLOMA PROGRAM;

22 (2) IS APPROVED BY THE COLLEGE BOARD AS AN ADVANCED 23 PLACEMENT COURSE;

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (3) CONSTITUTES ALL OR PART OF A COMPARABLE PROGRAM THAT 2 IS WIDELY RECOGNIZED BY INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION AS CONFERRING 3 COLLEGE CREDIT; OR

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(4) IS OFFERED BY AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

5 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A COUNTY BOARD THAT HAS A 6 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION 7 AUTHORIZING A HIGH SCHOOL TEACHER TO TEACH A DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSE 8 OFFERED BY THE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

9 (C) A COUNTY BOARD SHALL ALLOW A HIGH SCHOOL TEACHER TO TEACH A 10 DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSE OFFERED BY THE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION 11 IF THE TEACHER HAS:

12 (1) EARNED A MASTER'S DEGREE OR A HIGHER DEGREE IN THE FIELD 13 IN WHICH THE TEACHER IS OFFERING INSTRUCTION; OR

- 14 (2) (I) EARNED A MASTER'S DEGREE OR A HIGHER DEGREE;
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(II) TAUGHT A COLLEGE–LEVEL COURSE;

16(III) RECEIVEDPROFESSIONALDEVELOPMENTIN17COLLEGE-LEVEL TEACHING FROM THE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION; AND

18 (IV) BEEN OBSERVED AND APPROVED FOR INSTRUCTION BY A 19 FULL-TIME FACULTY MEMBER OF THE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE 20 DEPARTMENT IN WHICH THE CLASS IS TAUGHT.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 22 1, 2020.
