SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 (a) (1) The Department shall adopt by regulation, as the Maryland Building 16 Performance Standards, the International Building Code, including the International 17 Energy Conservation Code, with the modifications incorporated by the Department under 18 subsection (b) of this section.

- 19 (2) The Department shall adopt each subsequent version of the Standards 20 within [18] **36** months after it is issued.
- 21 (b) (1) Before adopting each version of the Standards, the Department shall:

(i) review the International Building Code to determine whether
 modifications should be incorporated in the Standards;
 (ii) consider changes to the International Building Code to enhance
 energy conservation and efficiency;

5 (iii) subject to the provisions of paragraph (2)(ii) of this subsection, 6 adopt modifications to the Standards that allow any innovative approach, design, 7 equipment, or method of construction that can be demonstrated to offer performance that 8 is at least the equivalent to the requirements of:

- (vi) hold a public hearing on each proposed modification.
- 17 (2) (i) Except as provided in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph and § 18 12–510 of this subtitle, the Department may not adopt, as part of the Standards, a 19 modification of a building code requirement that is more stringent than the requirement in 20 the International Building Code.

(ii) The Department may adopt energy conservation requirements
 that are more stringent than the requirements in the International Energy Conservation
 Code, but may not adopt energy conservation requirements that are less stringent than the
 requirements in the International Energy Conservation Code.

(c) The Standards apply to each building or structure in the State for which a
building permit application is received by a local jurisdiction on or after August 1, 1995.

27 (d) In addition to the Standards, the Department may adopt by regulation the28 International Green Construction Code.

29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 October 1, 2020.
