13	(2) the licenses were issued before June 1, 1982.
14 15 16	(c) The prohibition against issuing multiple licenses for the same person or premises does not apply to a Class B-ECF/DS, CLASS B-BW (ON-SALE), OR CLASS B-BWL (ON-SALE) license.
