FOR the purpose of prohibiting, beginning on a certain date, a food service business from providing a single-use plastic straw to a certain customer unless the customer

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 16 Products" be added to immediately precede Section 9–2101 of Article Environment of the
- 17 Annotated Code of Maryland.
