14 15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.
- 19 **(B) (1)** In this section the following words have the meanings 20 indicated.
- 21 (2) (I) "DISPOSABLE BAG" MEANS A PAPER OR PLASTIC BAG 22 PROVIDED BY A STORE TO A CUSTOMER AT THE POINT OF SALE.



- 1 (II) "DISPOSABLE BAG" DOES NOT INCLUDE:
- 1. A DURABLE PLASTIC BAG WITH HANDLES THAT IS AT
- 3 LEAST 2.25 MILS THICK AND IS DESIGNED AND MANUFACTURED FOR MULTIPLE
- 4 REUSE;
- 5 2. A BAG USED TO:
- A. PACKAGE BULK ITEMS, INCLUDING FRUIT, VEGETABLES, NUTS, GRAINS, CANDY, OR SMALL HARDWARE ITEMS;
- 8 B. CONTAIN OR WRAP FROZEN FOODS, MEAT, OR FISH,
- 9 WHETHER PREPACKAGED OR NOT;
- 10 C. CONTAIN OR WRAP FLOWERS, POTTED PLANTS, OR
- 11 OTHER DAMP ITEMS;
- 12 D. CONTAIN UNWRAPPED PREPARED FOODS OR BAKERY
- 13 GOODS; OR
- E. CONTAIN A NEWSPAPER OR DRY CLEANING;
- 3. A BAG PROVIDED BY A PHARMACIST TO CONTAIN
- 16 PRESCRIPTION DRUGS; OR
- 4. PLASTIC BAGS SOLD IN PACKAGES CONTAINING
- 18 MULTIPLE PLASTIC BAGS INTENDED FOR USE AS GARBAGE, PET WASTE, OR YARD
- 19 WASTE BAGS.
- 20 (3) "STORE" MEANS A RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT THAT PROVIDES
- 21 DISPOSABLE BAGS TO CUSTOMERS AS A RESULT OF THE SALE OF A PRODUCT.
- 22 (C) (1) THE COUNTY MAY IMPOSE, BY LAW, A FEE ON A STORE FOR THE
- 23 USE OF DISPOSABLE BAGS AS A PART OF A RETAIL SALE OF PRODUCTS.
- 24 (2) THE FEE IMPOSED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION
- 25 MAY NOT EXCEED 5 CENTS FOR EACH DISPOSABLE BAG USED.
- 26 (D) THE COUNTY MAY USE THE REVENUE FROM A FEE IMPOSED UNDER
- 27 SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION ONLY:
- 28 (1) FOR AN ENVIRONMENTAL PURPOSE, INCLUDING THE

- 1 ESTABLISHMENT OF A PROGRAM TO PROVIDE REUSABLE BAGS TO INDIVIDUALS IN
- 2 THE COUNTY;
- 3 (2) FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION, ADMINISTRATION, AND
- 4 ENFORCEMENT OF THE FEE;
- 5 (3) FOR LITTER CLEAN-UP, ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP, AND
- 6 PROGRAMS THAT SUPPORT RESIDENTS, INCLUDING THE RAIN CHECK REBATE
- 7 PROGRAM; AND
- 8 (4) FOR PARTIALLY OFFSETTING THE ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE OF
- 9 RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS FOR COLLECTING AND REMITTING THE FEE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
