1 AN ACT concerning

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- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the method for filling a vacancy on the Frederick County Board 4 of Education; specifying that an individual appointed to fill a vacancy serves for the 5 remainder of a certain term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies except 6 that under certain circumstances the individual serves only until a successor is 7 elected at the next general election; specifying how certain positions are to be filled 8 at a general election; establishing the manner for nominating candidates for vacated 9 offices; establishing the term of an individual elected to fill a vacated position; and 10 generally relating to the Frederick County Board of Education.

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

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- 29 (6) A CANDIDATE ELECTED TO FILL A VACATED POSITION SHALL

- 31 SHALL CONTINUE TO SERVE FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE VACATED TERM AND
- 32 UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS ELECTED AND QUALIFIES.
