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## Health Insurance – Pediatric Autoimmune Neuropsychiatric Disorders – Coverage

FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Medical Assistance Program, beginning on a certain date, to provide services for pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute onset neuropsychiatric syndrome under certain circumstances and subject to a certain provision of this Act; requiring insurers, nonprofit health service plans, and health maintenance organizations that provide certain health insurance benefits under certain insurance policies or contracts to provide coverage for certain diagnosis, evaluation, and treatment of pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute onset neuropsychiatric syndrome; providing that a certain provision of this Act does not require coverage for a certain drug except under certain circumstances; providing that the required coverage may be subject to certain deductibles, copayments, and coinsurance; requiring that pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute onset neuropsychiatric syndrome be coded for billing and diagnosis purposes in a certain manner under certain circumstances; providing for the application of this Act; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to coverage for pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorder and pediatric acute onset neuropsychiatric syndrome diagnosis, evaluation, and treatment under health insurance.
