A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Queen Anne's County – Alcoholic Beverages – Financial Interest**

3 FOR the purpose of defining the phrase “financial interest” as it applies to applications for
4 alcoholic beverages licenses in Queen Anne's County; and generally relating to
5 alcoholic beverages licenses in Queen Anne's County.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

19 4–109.

20 (a) A license application shall state:

21 (11) whether the applicant has a financial interest in the business to be
22 conducted under the license;

23 (13) that the applicant or a person on behalf of whom the application is filed

1 does not have a financial interest in any other place of business in the jurisdiction for which
2 an alcoholic beverage license has been applied for or issued;

3 (16) that during the term of the license, a person other than the applicant
4 will not have a financial interest in the license or in the business to be conducted under the
5 license;

9 (c) The following sections of Title 4, Subtitle 1 ("Applications for Local Licenses")
10 of Division I of this article apply in the county:

11 (4) § 4-109 ("Required information on application — In general"), subject
12 to § 27-1404 of this subtitle.

13 27-1404.

14 (A) An applicant for a license shall:

15 (1) include a statement in the application that the applicant is at least 21
16 years old; and

17 (2) submit an affidavit verifying the application.

18 (B) (1) **EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A**
19 **LICENSE HOLDER SHALL MEET ALL REQUIREMENTS OF THE RESPECTIVE LICENSES.**

20 (2) **THE TERM "FINANCIAL INTEREST" AS USED IN § 4-109(A)(11),**
21 **(13), AND (16) OF THIS ARTICLE REFERS TO AN APPLICANT WHO IS THE OWNER OF A**
22 **CONTROLLING INTEREST IN A PLACE OF BUSINESS WHERE OR FOR WHICH A LICENSE**
23 **HAS BEEN APPLIED FOR OR ISSUED.**

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
25 1, 2020.
