A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Circuit Court Real Property Records Improvement Fund – Surcharge on**
3 **Recordable Instruments**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the amount of the surcharge on certain recordable instruments
5 that the State Court Administrator is required to establish for the Circuit Court Real
6 Property Records Improvement Fund; and generally relating to the Circuit Court
7 Real Property Records Improvement Fund.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

16 13–604.

17 (a) [(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the] **THE**
18 Administrator shall establish a surcharge of [**\$20**] **\$40** for each type of recordable
19 instrument to be recorded among the land records and the financing statement records.

20 [(2) For recordable instruments executed on or after July 1, 2011, but before
21 July 1, 2020, the surcharge established under this subsection shall be \$40 for each type of
22 recordable instrument to be recorded among the land records and the financing statement
23 records.]

1 (b) The surcharge shall be collected by the office of the clerk of the circuit court
2 for each county.

3 (c) The surcharge may not be charged to an entity that is exempt from the
4 payment of fees under § 3–603 of the Real Property Article.

5 (d) Receipts from the surcharge shall be placed in the Fund and used by the
6 Administrator for the purposes of the Fund.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2020.
