17 18	WHEREAS, Volunteer first responders provide an invaluable service to the State and counties in Maryland; and
19 20 21	WHEREAS, The State and the majority of counties in Maryland provide workers' compensation benefits to volunteers and individuals who volunteer for local fire and rescue companies while on duty; now, therefore,
22 23	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
