# A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Higher Education – Nonresident Tuition – Exemption for Spouses and Dependents of Honorably Discharged Veterans

# FOR the purpose of exempting a spouse or financially dependent child of an honorably discharged veteran of the United States armed forces from paying nonresident tuition at certain institutions subject to certain documentation; repealing a requirement that certain public institutions of higher education comply with certain federal law; defining a certain term; and generally relating to nonresident tuition exemptions for spouses and financially dependent children of honorably discharged veterans at public institutions of higher education in the State.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

4 [(c)] (D) Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, a spouse or 5 financially dependent child of an active duty member OR HONORABLY DISCHARGED 6 VETERAN who enrolls as an entering student in a public institution of higher education 7 and is exempt from paying nonresident tuition under subsection [(b)] (C) of this section 8 shall continue to be exempt from paying nonresident tuition if:

9 (1) The active duty member **OR HONORABLY DISCHARGED VETERAN** no 10 longer meets the requirements of subsection **[**(b)(1)**] (C)** of this section; and

11 (2) The spouse or financially dependent child remains continuously 12 enrolled at the public institution of higher education.

13 [(d) Each public institution of higher education shall comply with federal law 14 relating to nonresident tuition for veterans and veterans' dependents.]

15 (e) The Commission shall adopt regulations in accordance with Title 10, Subtitle 16 1 of the State Government Article to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2020.
