A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County Board of Education – Student Member – Scholarship**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the amount of the scholarship granted to a certain student
4 member of the Baltimore County Board of Education; providing for the application
5 of this Act; and generally relating to the student member of the Baltimore County
6 Board of Education.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Education**

15 3–2B–06.

16 (a) (1) Each nonstudent member of the county board is entitled to receive
17 \$7,500 annually as compensation.

18 (2) A student member who completes a full term on the county board shall
19 be granted a scholarship of [~~\$1,000~~] **\$7,500** to be applied toward the student’s higher
20 education costs.

21 (b) After submitting vouchers under the regulations adopted by the county board,
22 a member is entitled to the allowances for travel and other expenses provided for in the
23 Baltimore County budget.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35
2 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the
3 scholarship amount for the student member of the Baltimore County Board of Education
4 while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the
5 provisions of this Act concerning the scholarship amount for the student member of the
6 Baltimore County Board of Education shall take effect at the beginning of the next following
7 term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the
8 effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.

9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
10 1, 2020.
