## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County Board of Education – Student Member – Scholarship**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the amount of the scholarship granted to a certain student  
4 member of the Baltimore County Board of Education; providing for the application  
5 of this Act; and generally relating to the student member of the Baltimore County  
6 Board of Education.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Education**

15 3–2B–06.

16 (a) (1) Each nonstudent member of the county board is entitled to receive  
17 \$7,500 annually as compensation.

1                   (2)     A student member who completes a full term on the county board shall  
2 be granted a scholarship of [~~\$1,000~~] **\$7,500** to be applied toward the student's higher  
3 education costs.

4                   (b)     After submitting vouchers under the regulations adopted by the county board,  
5 a member is entitled to the allowances for travel and other expenses provided for in the  
6 Baltimore County budget.

7                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35  
8 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the  
9 scholarship amount for the student member of the Baltimore County Board of Education  
10 while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the  
11 provisions of this Act concerning the scholarship amount for the student member of the  
12 Baltimore County Board of Education shall take effect at the beginning of the next following  
13 term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the  
14 effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.

15                   SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
16 1, 2020.
