A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

State Retirement and Pension System - Military Service - Purchase of Credit

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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- 17 (a) (1) This section applies to an individual who is:
- (i) a member of a State system; or
- 19 (ii) a former member of a State system who is eligible to receive a
- 20 benefit under § 29–302 or § 29–303 of this article.
- 21 (2) This section does not apply to a retiree of a State system.
- 22 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, an individual described in

- subsection (a) of this section, who has not met the conditions set forth in § 38–103(a)(2) 1 2 through (4) of this subtitle, is entitled to receive service credit for military service only on 3 the attainment of 10 years of service credit earned through employment as a member of a 4 State system. 5 (c) An individual described in subsection (a) of this section may not receive 6 credit for that military service if the individual receives credit for military service from 7 another retirement system for which retirement benefits have been or will be received by 8 the individual. 9 (2) Paragraph (1) of this subsection does not apply to: 10 (i) credit for military service provided under: 1. 11 the Social Security Act; 12 2. the National Railroad Retirement Act; or 13 3. - 30 **(2)** AN INDIVIDUAL MAY PURCHASE UP TO 5 YEARS OF SERVICE CREDIT AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION FOR MILITARY SERVICE IN EXCESS OF 31 THE MAXIMUM SERVICE CREDIT ALLOWED UNDER SUBSECTION (C)(3) OF THIS 32 33 SECTION.

- 1 (3) (I) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PURCHASES SERVICE CREDIT UNDER 2 THIS SUBSECTION SHALL:
- 1. COMPLETE A CLAIM FOR THE SERVICE CREDIT AND
 4 FILE IT WITH THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD OF
 5 TRUSTEES PROVIDES; AND
- 2. PAY TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE ANNUITY RESERVE AND PENSION RESERVE REQUIRED TO FUND THE ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCE.
- 9 (II) THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL PAY FOR SERVICE CREDIT 10 PURCHASED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IN A SINGLE PAYMENT AT RETIREMENT.
- [(d)] (E) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the service credit for military service that an individual receives under this section shall be applied to the individual's retirement allowance using the accrual rate in effect at the time the individual retires from a State system.
- 15 (2) If an individual applies for military service credit on or after July 1, 16 2011, the service credit for military service that the individual receives under this section 17 shall be applied to the individual's retirement allowance using the accrual rate in effect at 18 the time the individual submits an application for military service credit to the State 19 Retirement Agency.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
