1 AN ACT concerning

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3	FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to charge a certain
4	additional fee on the issuance of special registration plates for recipients of an
5	individually earned, combat-related armed forces medal; requiring that the
6	additional fee under this Act be credited to the Maryland Veterans Trust Fund;
7	making technical corrections; and generally relating to the fees charged for certain
8	special registration plates for veterans.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

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## 1 Article - State Government 2 9-913. 3 (e) (1) There is a Maryland Veterans Trust established for the purpose of 4 providing monetary and other assistance to: veterans and their families: and 5 (i) 6 (ii) public and private programs that support veterans and their 7 families. **(2)** 8 There is a Maryland Veterans Trust Fund. The Fund consists of: 9 (g) 10 (1) gifts and grants that the Trust receives under § 9-914.2(a)(1) of this 11 subtitle; and contributions to the Fund from: 12(2) 13 the sale of tickets from instant ticket lottery machines under § 14 9–112(d) of this title; [and] 15 the donations from video lottery facility players under § (ii) 9-1A-04(d)(19) of this [article] TITLE; AND 16 (III) THE DESIGNATED FEES FROM SPECIAL REGISTRATION 17 PLATES FOR RECIPIENTS OF AN INDIVIDUALLY EARNED, COMBAT-RELATED ARMED 18 FORCES MEDAL UNDER § 13–619.1 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE. 19 20 Article - Transportation 21 13-619.1. 22The owner of a motor vehicle, or a lessee of the vehicle under a lease not (1)23 intended as security, or a director, officer, employee, or partner of a business entity that 24owns the vehicle may apply to the Administration for the assignment of a special 25registration number and special registration plates under this section for a vehicle included 26 in one of the following classes: 27 (i) A Class A (passenger) vehicle; 28 A Class E (truck) vehicle with a one ton or less manufacturer's (ii) 29 rated capacity;

A Class M (multipurpose) vehicle; or

(iii)

- 1 (iv) A Class D (motorcycle) vehicle.
- 2 (2) To be eligible for a special registration described under subsection 3 (c)(2)(i) of this section, an applicant shall provide proof that is satisfactory to the 4 Administration that the applicant is a recipient of an individually earned, 5 combat—related[,] armed forces medal.
- 6 (3) To be eligible for a special registration described under subsection 7 (c)(2)(ii) of this section, an applicant shall provide proof that is satisfactory to the 8 Administration that the applicant is an honorably discharged veteran of a branch of the 9 armed forces of the United States.
- 10 (4) To be eligible for a special registration described under subsection (c)(2)(iii) of this section, an applicant shall provide proof that is satisfactory to the Administration that the applicant is a recipient of the U.S. Department of Defense Gold Star for surviving spouses, parents, and next of kin of members of the armed forces who lost their lives in combat.
- 15 (b) (1) In addition to the annual registration fee otherwise required under this 16 title, an owner of a vehicle assigned a special registration under this section shall pay a fee 17 as determined by the Administration each time new registration plates are issued for the vehicle.
- 19 **(2)** The fee shall be calculated to [recover]:
- 20 **(I) RECOVER** the costs incurred by the Administration in carrying 21 out the provisions of this section; **AND**
- 22 (II) RESULT IN A SURPLUS OF AT LEAST \$10 FOR EACH 23 ISSUANCE OF NEW REGISTRATION PLATES UNDER THIS SECTION.
- [(2) The additional fee charged under this section shall be retained by the Administration for the purpose of recovering the Administration's costs under this section, and may not be credited to the Gasoline and Motor Vehicle Revenue Account for distribution under § 8–403 or § 8–404 of this article.]
- 28 (3) (I) THE PORTION OF THE ADDITIONAL FEE CHARGED UNDER 29 PARAGRAPH (2)(I) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE RETAINED BY THE 30 ADMINISTRATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECOVERING THE ADMINISTRATION'S 31 COSTS UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 32 (II) THE PORTION OF THE ADDITIONAL FEE CHARGED UNDER 33 PARAGRAPH (2)(II) OF THIS SUBSECTION:
  - 1. MAY NOT BE RETAINED BY OR TRANSFERRED TO ANY

- SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE MARYLAND VETERANS 2 2. 3 TRUST FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 9–913 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE. 4 (III) NO PORTION OF THE ADDITIONAL FEE CHARGED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY BE CREDITED TO THE GASOLINE AND MOTOR VEHICLE 5 REVENUE ACCOUNT FOR DISTRIBUTION UNDER § 8-403 OR § 8-404 OF THIS 6 7 ARTICLE. 8 (c) Special registration plates issued under this section: 9 (1) May consist of any combination of letters, numerals, or both; and Shall include: 10 (2) 11 For registration plates issued for an applicant described in 12 subsection (a)(2) of this section: 13 1. An emblem or logo as authorized by the Administration 14 that depicts the applicant's armed forces medal; and 15 2. Except on plates issued for Class D (motorcycle) vehicles, words describing the medal printed across the bottom of the plates; 16 17 (ii) Words or an emblem or logo indicating that the special registration plate holder is an honorably discharged veteran of a branch of the armed forces 18 19 of the United States: or 20 An emblem or logo indicating that the registration plate holder 21is the recipient of the U.S. Department of Defense Gold Star. 22 (d) The Administration, in consultation with the U.S. Department of 23Defense and appropriate representatives of the various branches of the armed forces, shall 24adopt regulations specifying those armed forces medals that are of the type described in 25subsection (a)(2) of this section and which, when awarded to an individual, qualify that 26 individual to apply for special registration under this section. 27 The Administration may adopt other regulations as necessary to govern the issuance of special registration numbers and special registration plates under this 2829 section.
- 30 (e) If, whether by act of the parties or by operation of law, the title or ownership 31 interest in a vehicle assigned a special registration under this section is transferred from 32 the joint names of a husband and wife to the individual name of either spouse, the 33 transferee may continue to use the same special registration plates issued under this

- 1 section on the vehicle after the transfer.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 3  $\,$  1, 2020.
