- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the authority and responsibilities of the Maryland Emergency 4 Management Agency (MEMA); altering a certain explanation of purpose for certain provisions of law; stating the policy of the State with regard to certain emergency 5 6 management activities and operations; requiring MEMA to prepare for certain 7 emergency management activities and operations; providing for the circumstances 8 under which MEMA may assume authority for responding to an emergency; defining certain terms; altering certain defined terms; altering the applicability of certain 9 10 definitions; making conforming changes; and generally relating to the Maryland 11 Emergency Management Agency.

- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 23 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Public Safety

- 2 (a) In this [subtitle] TITLE the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 3 (b) "Director" means the Director of MEMA.
- 4 (c) "Emergency" means the **IMMINENT** threat or occurrence of [:
- 5 (1) a hurricane, tornado, storm, flood, high water, wind-driven water, tidal 6 wave, earthquake, landslide, mudslide, snowstorm, drought, fire, explosion, and any other 7 disaster in any part of the State that requires State assistance to supplement local efforts 8 in order to save lives and protect public health and safety; or
- 9 an enemy attack, act of terrorism, or public health catastrophel **(2)** 10 SEVERE OR WIDESPREAD LOSS OF LIFE, INJURY, OR OTHER HEALTH IMPACTS, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR DESTRUCTION, SOCIAL OR ECONOMIC DISRUPTION, OR 11 12 **ENVIRONMENTAL DEGRADATION FROM** NATURAL, TECHNOLOGICAL, OR 13 **HUMAN-MADE CAUSES.**
- 14 "Emergency management" means the [preparation for and carrying out (d) 15 of functions in an emergency in order to save lives and to minimize and repair injury and 16 damage that result from emergencies beyond the capabilities of local authorities] PLANNING, IMPLEMENTING, AND CONDUCTING OF RISK REDUCTION AND 17 18 CONSEQUENCE MANAGEMENT ACTIVITIES ACROSS THE MISSION AREAS OF 19 PREVENTION, PROTECTION, MITIGATION, RESPONSE, AND RECOVERY TO ENHANCE 20 PREPAREDNESS, SAVE LIVES, PRESERVE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY, PROTECT PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PROPERTY, AND MINIMIZE OR REPAIR INJURY AND DAMAGE 2122THAT RESULTS OR MAY RESULT FROM EMERGENCIES.
- 23 (2) "Emergency management" does not include the preparation for and 24 carrying out of functions in an emergency for which military forces are primarily 25 responsible.
- 26 (e) ["Local organization for emergency management" means an organization established by a political subdivision or other local authority under § 14–109 of this subtitle.

- 13 (a) To ensure that the State will be adequately prepared to deal with emergencies
- 14 [that are beyond the capabilities of local authorities, to provide for the common defense],

- and property of the people of the State, AND TO ENSURE THE SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC
- 17 **RESILIENCE OF THE STATE,** it is necessary to:
