A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Vehicle Laws - Overtaking and Passing Bicycles, EPAMDs, or Motor Scooters

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the driver of a vehicle to drive on the left side of the
- 4 roadway in a no-passing zone to overtake and pass a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor
- 5 scooter in accordance with a certain provision of law under certain circumstances;
- 6 repealing a certain exception to the 3-foot clearance rule for a vehicle passing a
- bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter; clarifying certain language; making a
- 8 stylistic change; and generally relating to overtaking and passing bicycles, EPAMDs,

- 1 (d) The driver of a vehicle may drive [across]:
- 2 **(1) ACROSS** the left side of the roadway in a no–passing zone while making 3 a left turn, but only if it is safe to do so; **AND**
- 4 (2) ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE ROADWAY IN A NO-PASSING ZONE TO
 5 MAKE THE MINIMUM ADJUSTMENT NECESSARY TO OVERTAKE AND PASS AT A SAFE
- 6 AND LAWFUL DISTANCE A BICYCLE, AN EPAMD, OR A MOTOR SCOOTER TRAVELING
- 7 IN THE SAME DIRECTION IF:

- 15 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, the driver of a vehicle shall:
- 16 (1) Exercise due care to avoid colliding with any bicycle, EPAMD, or motor scooter being ridden by a person; and
- When overtaking a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter, pass safely at a distance of not less than 3 feet, unless, at the time:
- 20 (i) The bicycle, EPAMD, or motor scooter rider fails to operate the
- 21 vehicle in conformance with § 21–1205(a) of this subtitle ("Riding to right side of roadway")
- 22 or § 21-1205.1(b) of this subtitle ("Roadway with bike lane or shoulder paved to smooth
- 23 surface"); OR
- 24 (ii) A passing clearance of less than 3 feet is caused solely by the
- 25 bicycle, EPAMD, or motor scooter rider failing to maintain a steady course [; or
- 26 (iii) The highway on which the vehicle is being driven is not wide
- 27 enough to lawfully pass the bicycle, EPAMD, or motor scooter at a distance of at least 3
- 28 feet].

- 30 October 1, 2020.
