A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Task Force to Evaluate Existing School Civic Literacy Programs

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force to Evaluate Existing School Civic Literacy 4 Programs; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task Force; $\mathbf{5}$ prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Task Force to 6 7 evaluate, determine, and make recommendations regarding certain matters; 8 requiring the Task Force to report its findings and recommendations to the State 9 Department of Education, the Governor, and the General Assembly on or before a 10 certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to 11 establishing the Task Force to Evaluate Existing School Civic Literacy Programs.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 13 That:

- 14 (a) There is a Task Force to Evaluate Existing School Civic Literacy Programs.
- 15 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- 16 (1) five members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of17 the Senate;
- 18 (2) five members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of 19 the House; and
- 20 (3) five members with expertise in the area of civic literacy, appointed by 21 the Governor.
- 22 (c) The Task Force shall elect a chair from among its members.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 15 1, 2020. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the end of July 16 31, 2021, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be 17 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
