 EDUCATION SHALL ADOPT A RETENTION POLICY FOR THE FINANCIAL RECORDS OF
 THE BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM.

(2) THE BOARD TO DESIGNATE A CUSTODIAN OF RECORDS;

### 2 (3) THE CUSTODIAN OF RECORDS TO CERTIFY ANY RECORDS THAT 3 HAVE BEEN DIGITALLY STORED FOR 7 YEARS OR MORE; AND

- 4 (4) ALL FINANCIAL RECORDS TO BE BACKED UP IN A SECURE 5 SECONDARY CLOUD-BASED LOCATION.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 7 1, 2020.
