- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to appoint additional members to the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County; requiring that members be appointed from each legislative district in the county; requiring certain members of the General Assembly jointly to select an individual to be recommended to the Governor for a certain appointment; limiting the number of terms that each member may serve on the Board; staggering the terms of members of the Board; altering certain requirements for political diversity among the members of the Board; authorizing the Board, rather than the Governor, to designate a chair of the Board; 12 specifying the expiration of the terms of the members of the Board; and generally relating to the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County.


