- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a county board may count toward high school attendance [the]:
- 8 **(1) THE** time an apprentice or youth apprentice spends during 9 work–based training with an employer under a registered apprenticeship program; **AND**
- 10 (2) THE TIME A STUDENT SPENDS DURING VOCATIONAL TRAINING IN
