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Real Property - Residential Leases - Voter Registration

- FOR the purpose of requiring a landlord to provide certain individuals with a State voter registration application within a certain number of days after the date of occupancy;
- 5 making a landlord liable for certain damages for failure to comply with this Act;
- providing that this Act may not be construed to require a landlord to assist a resident
- with completion of a State voter registration application; and generally relating to

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Article - Real Property

- 18 (A) NOT LATER THAN 15 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF OCCUPANCY, A
- 19 LANDLORD SHALL PROVIDE A TENANT WITH A STATE VOTER REGISTRATION
- 20 APPLICATION FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL AT LEAST 16 YEARS OLD WHO IS AUTHORIZED
- 21 TO RESIDE AT THE RESIDENTIAL RENTAL PROPERTY.
- 22 (B) (1) A LANDLORD THAT FAILS TO COMPLY WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF
- 23 THIS SECTION SHALL BE LIABLE FOR \$25 IN DAMAGES FOR EACH VOTER
- 24 REGISTRATION APPLICATION THAT THE LANDLORD FAILED TO PROVIDE.



- 1 (2) A LANDLORD MAY RAISE AS A DEFENSE ALL REASONABLE
- 2 ATTEMPTS BY THE LANDLORD TO DELIVER THE VOTER REGISTRATION
- 3 APPLICATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
- 4 (C) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION MAY BE CONSTRUED TO REQUIRE A
- 5 LANDLORD TO ASSIST A RESIDENT WITH COMPLETION OF A STATE VOTER
- 6 REGISTRATION APPLICATION.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 8 October 1, 2020.
