# 1(2)UP TO 20% OF THE MONEY AVAILABLE TO THE PROGRAM MAY BE2PROVIDED TO AN EMPLOYER WITH MORE THAN 150 EMPLOYEES AND 500 OR FEWER3EMPLOYEES BASED IN THE STATE.

4 (2) (3) Up to 20% of the money available to the Program, NOT TO EXCEED 5 **\$200,000**, may be provided to an employer with more than 500 employees based in the 6 State, if the employer:

7 (i) is primarily engaged in manufacturing or in a technology-based8 business;

9 (ii) agrees to increase purchases of goods produced in the State and 10 services from suppliers based in the State; and

(iii) agrees to provide the workforce training to the number of
employees based in the State, as determined by the Program, of smaller employers located
in the State that supply goods or services to the employer receiving the money.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2020.
