- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a foreign corporation to certify that the State Department of Assessments and Taxation is the corporation's resident agent when registering 5 6 with the Department; authorizing a foreign corporation to certify that the 7 Department is the corporation's resident agent when qualifying with the 8 Department; authorizing the Department to act as a resident agent for a foreign 9 corporation that does business in the State without a resident agent or with a 10 resident agent who cannot be found or served with the exercise of reasonable 11 diligence; making a stylistic change; and generally relating to resident agents of foreign corporations. 12

(ii) 20 [(c)] **(D)** Except as provided in subsection [(d)] (E) of this section, each 21certification by a foreign corporation which relates to its resident agent, address, or 22principal office shall be executed for the corporation by its president or one of its 23vice-presidents. 24[(d)] **(E)** A foreign corporation and its resident agent may change the resident 25agent, his address, or the address of a principal office of the corporation in the same manner as provided for a Maryland corporation under § 2–108 of this article. 2627 [(e)] **(F)** A resident agent of a foreign corporation may resign by filing (1)
 - (2) Unless a later time is specified in the resignation, it is effective:

with the Department a counterpart or photocopy of his signed resignation.

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- 1 (i) At the time it is filed with the Department, if the corporation has 2 appointed a successor resident agent; or
- 3 (ii) Ten days after it is filed with the Department, if the corporation 4 has not appointed a successor resident agent.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2020.
