- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

2 (d) (1) An apprentice barber under complete and constant supervision of a 3 master barber may assist the master barber in starting or completing an operation. The 4 master barber or barbershop may charge the usual fees for the operation.

5 (2) A fee may not be charged for an operation performed completely by an 6 apprentice barber.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2020.
