- 1 (B) THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL CERTIFY TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT THE 2 COURSE MAY COUNT TOWARD THE MATHEMATICS GRADUATION REQUIREMENT.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 4 $\,$ 1, 2020.
