

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1 "Work zone speed control system" means a device having one or more 2 motor vehicle sensors connected to a camera system capable of producing recorded images 3 of motor vehicles traveling at or above a predetermined speed in or approaching a work 4 zone. 5 (d) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2) through (4) of this (1) subsection, a local police department, State police department, or police department 6 7 contractor shall mail to the owner liable under subsection (c) of this section a citation that 8 shall include: 9 (i) The name and address of the registered owner of the vehicle: 10 The registration number of the motor vehicle involved in the (ii) 11 violation; 12 (iii) The violation charged; 13 (iv) The location where the violation occurred; 14 (v) The date and time of the violation; 15 (vi) At least one recorded image of the vehicle with a data bar imprinted on each image that includes the speed of the vehicle and the date and time the 16 17 image was recorded; 18 The amount of the civil penalty imposed and the date by which (vii) the civil penalty should be paid; 19 20 (viii) A signed statement by a police officer employed by the local police 21department or State police department that, based on inspection of recorded images, the 22motor vehicle was being operated in violation of this subtitle; 23A statement that recorded images are evidence of a violation of (ix) this subtitle; 2425(x) Information advising the person alleged to be liable under this 26 section of the manner and time in which liability as alleged in the citation may be contested in the District Court; and 27 28 Information advising the person alleged to be liable under this (xi) 29 section that failure to pay the civil penalty or to contest liability in a [timely manner] 30 WITHIN 60 DAYS: 1. Is an admission of liability; 31

May result in the refusal to register the motor vehicle; and

May result in the suspension of the motor vehicle 2 registration. 3 (2)The local police department or State police department may mail a 4 warning notice instead of a citation to the owner liable under subsection (c) of this section. 5 Except as provided in subsection (f)(4) of this section, the local police 6 department or State police department may not mail a citation to a person who is not an 7 owner. Except as provided in subsection (f)(4) of this section, a citation issued 8 **(4)** 9 under this section shall be mailed no later than 2 weeks after the alleged violation if the 10 vehicle is registered in this State, and no later than 30 days after the alleged violation if 11 the vehicle is registered in another state. 12 A person who receives a citation under paragraph (1) of this subsection (5)13 may: 14 (i) Pay the civil penalty in accordance with instructions on the 15 citation; or 16 Elect to stand trial in the District Court for the alleged violation. (ii)
