1 AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Traffic Control Signal Monitoring Systems, Speed Monitoring Systems, and Work Zone Speed Control Systems - Citation Responses

FOR the purpose of altering a certain warning on a citation issued for a violation recorded
by a traffic control signal monitoring system, a speed monitoring system, or a work
zone speed control system to state the number of days within which a person alleged
to be liable must take a certain action in order to avoid an automatic admission of
liability; and generally relating to citations issued for violations recorded by traffic
control signal monitoring systems, speed monitoring systems, or work zone speed
control systems.
