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
Vehicle Emissions Inspection Program – Exemptions – Vehicles With Low Annual Mileage

- 4 FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that, in order for a vehicle that is driven less 5 than a certain number of miles over a certain period of time to be exempt from 6 mandatory inspection and testing requirements, the owner of the vehicle must meet 7 certain disability or age requirements; decreasing the maximum number of miles a 8 motor vehicle may be driven annually in order to be exempt from mandatory 9 inspection and testing requirements; exempting certain vehicles from certain inspection and testing requirements under certain circumstances; and generally 10 11 relating to the exemption of certain vehicles from mandatory inspection and testing 12 requirements of the vehicle emissions inspection program.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 22 (a) (1) A motor vehicle [for which special registration plates have been issued
- 23 under § 13-616 of this article] is exempt from the mandatory inspections required by this
- 24 subtitle if:





- 1 (i) That all of the owners of the motor vehicle are at least 70 years 2 of age at the time of a scheduled mandatory inspection under this subtitle;
- 3 (ii) That the motor vehicle is being driven 5,000 miles or less 4 annually; and
- 5 (iii) The motor vehicle's odometer reading at the time of the 6 certification.
- 7 (3) The certification required in paragraph (2) of this subsection shall be 8 made on a form provided by the Administration.
- 9 (c)] The Administrator may adopt regulations as necessary to administer or 10 enforce the provisions of this section.
