A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Motor Vehicles – Registration – Class E (Truck) "Dump Service Registration" Vehicles

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the owner of a certain Class E (truck) "dump service registration" vehicle that is a farm vehicle to register the vehicle as a Class E "farm truck registration" vehicle; providing for the calculation of the annual registration fee for a Class E "dump service registration" vehicle registered as a Class E "farm truck registration" vehicle; and generally relating to vehicle registration for Class E (truck) "dump service registration" vehicles.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

3 4 5	(2) Is used only in the farmer's farming business and about the farmer's farm home and in hauling farm products and the labor, supplies, equipment, and other materials necessary for the operation of the farm and farm home; and		
$6 \\ 7$	(3) Is not used to haul farm products previously acquired by the farmer for resale or to haul farm products for hire for another person who is not a farmer.

9 10 11	(a) On application, the Administration shall issue a special Class E "dump service registration" to any applicant who certifies that the vehicle for which the application is made is a Class E (truck) vehicle that:

14	(2) Is to be used to haul feed or other loose materials in bulk.

16	(a) In this section, "farm truck" means a farm vehicle that:		
17	(1) (I) Is a Class E (truck) vehicle; and		
18 19	[(2)] (II) Has a shipping weight of its chassis and battery, as certified by the manufacturer, of more than 3/4 ton; OR		
20 21 22	(2) IS A CLASS E (TRUCK) "DUMP SERVICE REGISTRATION" VEHICLE WITH FOUR AXLES AND A MAXIMUM GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMITATION OF 70,000 POUNDS.		
$\begin{array}{c} 23 \\ 24 \end{array}$	(b) On application, the Administration shall issue a Class E "farm truck registration" to any applicant who certifies:		
25	(1) That the applicant is a farmer; and

$\frac{28}{29}$	(c) For each vehicle registered under this section, the annual registration fee is based on the maximum gross vehicle weight, as follows:		

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1	Maximum Gross Weight	Fee (per 1,000 Pounds
2	Limit (in Pounds)	or Fraction Thereof)
3	10,000 (minimum) – 40,000	\$5.00
4	40,001 – 65,000 (maximum)	\$5.25
5	70,000 ("DUMP SERVICE" MAXIMUM)	\$5.25

6 (d) Except as provided in § 8–602(c) of this article, a vehicle registered under this 7 section may not be used:

For hire except to haul farm products for another farmer; or
