Met all of the other requirements for licensure. 18 19 The Board [may] SHALL waive [any]: (e) 20 **(1)** ANY education requirement of subsection (d) of this section for an 21individual who was licensed, IN GOOD STANDING, and practiced as a nursing home 22 administrator for at least [3 years] 1 YEAR in another state; AND 23 THE EXAMINATION REQUIREMENT OF SUBSECTION (G) OF THIS SECTION FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS LICENSED, IN GOOD STANDING, AND 24PRACTICED AS A NURSING HOME ADMINISTRATOR FOR AT LEAST 5 YEARS IN 2526 ANOTHER STATE.
- 27 (g) Except as otherwise provided in this title, the applicant shall pass an examination given by the Board under this subtitle.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 October 1, 2020.
