A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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University of Maryland – Harford Memorial Hospital Closure – Economic Impact Study

FOR the purpose of requiring the University of Maryland Institute for Governmental Service and Research to conduct a study on the economic impact of the closure of Harford Memorial Hospital in Havre de Grace and the transfer of its services to another location; requiring the Institute to conduct the study in a certain manner; requiring the Institute to develop a revitalization plan for the City in a certain manner; requiring the Institute to report certain findings and information to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the economic impact of the closure of Harford Memorial Hospital.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 14 That:

- 15 (a) The University of Maryland Institute for Governmental Service and Research 16 shall conduct a study on the economic impact of the closure of Harford Memorial Hospital 17 and the subsequent transfer of its services to another campus under the University of 18 Maryland Upper Chesapeake Health System.
- 19 (b) (1) In conducting the study required under subsection (a) of this section, 20 the Institute shall quantify the economic impact of the hospital closure on the City of Havre 21 de Grace.
- 22 (2) The study shall consider:
- 23 (i) the impact on existing small businesses in downtown Havre de 24 Grace, including any displacement effect from new businesses established at the new 25 campus;

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1 (ii) the effect on employment at the existing facility at Harford 2 Memorial Hospital, including the costs and benefits of relocation to the new facility; 3 (iii) the effect on homeownership in the surrounding communities, including any effect on property values and on Harford County's property tax assessable 4 5 base; and 6 any other potential consequences for the City of Havre de Grace (iv) 7 from a prolonged vacancy at the current hospital site. 8 (c) The Institute shall develop a revitalization plan for the City of Hayre de Grace 9 that: 10 (1) is consistent with the City's current comprehensive plan; 11 (2)incorporates the findings of the economic impact study required under 12 subsection (a) of this section; and 13 includes opportunities for public-private investment from the local, (3)State, and University of Maryland Medical System partnership. 14 On or before December 1, 2020, the Institute shall report to the Senate 15 Finance Committee and the House Economic Matters Committee, in accordance with 16 17 § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, on the findings of the study required under 18 subsection (a) of this section and the revitalization plan required under subsection (c) of 19 this section. 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2020. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the end of June 212230, 2021, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be
