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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Sales and Use Tax – Exemption for Artificial Hearing Device Earmolds,**  
3 **Equipment, and Supplies**

4 FOR the purpose of exempting from the sales and use tax the sale of certain earmolds for  
5 artificial hearing devices and certain artificial hearing device–related equipment  
6 and supplies; and generally relating to a sales and use tax exemption for artificial  
7 hearing device earmolds, equipment, and supplies.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Tax – General**

16 11–211.

17 (b) The sales and use tax does not apply to a sale of:

18 (10) **(I)** a replacement cord for an artificial hearing device;

19 **(II) A CUSTOM–MADE EARMOLD FOR AN ARTIFICIAL HEARING**  
20 **DEVICE; OR**

21 **(III) ANY OTHER ARTIFICIAL HEARING DEVICE–RELATED**  
22 **EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES;**

1           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
2 1, 2020.
