A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Home Builder Registration and Home Improvement Licenses – Professional Education Requirements

4 FOR the purpose of requiring a registered home builder and a registered sales $\mathbf{5}$ representative to complete certain professional education requirements to qualify for 6 renewal of a registration or a registration certificate; requiring the Home Builder 7 and Home Builder Representative Registration Unit to waive a certain requirement 8 under certain circumstances; requiring a licensed contractor and a licensed 9 salesperson to complete certain professional education requirements to qualify for 10 renewal of a certain license; requiring the Home Improvement Commission to waive 11 a certain requirement under certain circumstances; providing for the duties of the 12Home Builder and Home Builder Sales Representative Registration Unit and the 13 Maryland Home Improvement Commission regarding certain professional education 14requirements for certain registrants or certain licensees; requiring the Unit or the 15Commission to approve the curriculum for a professional education course if the 16curriculum covers certain information; requiring the Unit or the Commission to 17approve the curriculum for a professional education course under certain 18 circumstances; requiring a certain person to submit the course curriculum to the 19Unit or the Commission for approval within a certain period of time; providing that 20a professional education course does not need to be conducted in the State to be 21 approved by the Unit or the Commission; requiring a person conducting a certain 22professional education course or the course instructor to submit certain documents 23to the Unit or the Commission or to a certain registrant or a certain licensee; 24requiring a certain document to include certain information; requiring a certain 25registrant or a certain licensee to submit certain information to the Unit or the 26Commission under certain circumstances; stating that the renewal of a certain 27registration or a certain license is not valid unless the registrant or licensee has met 28certain requirements; requiring the Maryland Department of Labor to adopt certain 29regulations; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to 30 professional education requirements for home builders, registered sales 31representatives, licensed contractors, and licensed salespersons.
