13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 Article Health General
- 16 15-114.1.

17 (a) In this section, "emergency service transporter" means a public entity or 18 volunteer fire, rescue, or emergency medical service that provides emergency medical 19 services.

20 (b) If an emergency service transporter charges for its services and requests 21 reimbursement from the Program, the Department shall reimburse the emergency service 22 transporter, in an amount as specified by regulations adopted by the Department, for the 23 cost of:

1 (1) Transportation the emergency service transporter provides to a 2 Program recipient to a facility in response to a 911 call; and

3 (2) Medical services the emergency service transporter provides to the 4 Program recipient [while transporting the Program recipient to a facility] in response to a 5 911 call.

6 (c) The Department shall adopt any regulations necessary to carry out this 7 section.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2020.
