5 FOR the purpose of allowing a subtraction modification under the Maryland income tax for
6 the value of a subsidy for rental expenses received by a resident of Howard County
7 under a certain program of the Downtown Columbia Plan; providing for the
8 application of this Act; and generally relating to a subtraction under the Maryland
9 income tax for the value of certain rental subsidies.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (a) To the extent included in federal adjusted gross income, the amounts under
4 this section are subtracted from the federal adjusted gross income of a resident to determine
5 Maryland adjusted gross income.

6 (HH) THE SUBTRACTION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION INCLUDES
7 THE VALUE OF A SUBSIDY FOR RENTAL EXPENSES RECEIVED BY A RESIDENT OF
8 HOWARD COUNTY UNDER THE “LIVE WHERE YOU WORK” PROGRAM OF THE
9 DOWNTOWN COLUMBIA PLAN.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
11 1, 2020, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after December 31, 2019.
