Comptroller - Duties - Designations of and Responses to Personal Representatives

FOR the purpose of requiring the Comptroller to provide a certain person a written response that confirms or denies the validity of a certain power of attorney form within a certain time frame; requiring the Comptroller to provide a certain personal representative certain tax-related documents within a certain period of time; and generally relating to duties of the Comptroller and personal representatives.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Tax General
- 17 **2–116.**

18 (A) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL PROVIDE TO A PERSON, WITHIN 2 BUSINESS 19 DAYS AFTER THE COMPTROLLER RECEIVES A POWER OF ATTORNEY FORM 20 DESIGNATING THE PERSON AS A PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE FOR ANOTHER 21 PERSON, A WRITTEN RESPONSE THAT CONFIRMS OR DENIES THE VALIDITY OF THE 22 EXECUTED POWER OF ATTORNEY FORM.

23(B)IF A PERSON WHO IS DESIGNATED AS A PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE IN24AN EXECUTED POWER OF ATTORNEY FORM REQUESTS TAX-RELATED DOCUMENTS



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- 1 REGARDING THE MATTER FOR WHICH THE PERSON IS DESIGNATED AS A PERSONAL
- 2 REPRESENTATIVE, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL PROVIDE THE DOCUMENTS WITHIN 2
 3 BUSINESS DAYS AFTER THE COMPTROLLER RECEIVES THE REQUEST.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2020.
