SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 (a) There is a Morgan State University Police Force.

22 (b) (1) A University police officer has the powers granted to a peace and police 23 officer.

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1 (2) However, a University police officer may exercise these powers only on 2 property that is owned, leased, operated by, or under the control of the University. The 3 police officer may not exercise these powers on any other property unless:

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(i) Engaged in fresh pursuit of a suspected offender;

5 (II) REQUESTED OR AUTHORIZED TO DO SO BY THE MAYOR OF 6 BALTIMORE CITY OR THE COMMISSIONER OF THE BALTIMORE POLICE 7 DEPARTMENT;

8 [(ii)] (III) Necessary to facilitate the orderly flow of traffic to and 9 from property owned, leased, operated by, or under the control of the University; or

10 [(iii)] (IV) Ordered to do so by the Governor.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2020.
