- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- This title applies only in Baltimore City.

- 22 (a) There is a Class B–D–7 beer, wine, and liquor license.

- 1 (b) (1) The Board may issue a Class B-D-7 license if the Board determines 2 that the license is reasonably necessary for the convenience of the public.
- 3 (2) In making the determination, the Board shall consider the number of 4 beer, wine, and liquor outlets in a given area and the number of days the outlets are open, 5 rather than the nature of the outlets.
- 6 (c) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor at retail 7 at the place described in the license, for on– and off–premises consumption.
- 8 (d) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the license 9 holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor during the hours and days set out under § 12–2004(c) 10 of this title.
- 11 (2) The hours of sale for a license holder in an area bounded by Liberty 12 Heights Avenue, Northern Parkway, Druid Park Drive, and Wabash Avenue are from 9
- 13 a.m. to 9 p.m.
- 14 12–2004.
- 15 (c) Except as provided in § 12–2005 of this subtitle, a holder of a Class B–D–7 beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor:
- 17 (1) FROM 9 A.M. TO 9 P.M. IN THE 4000 BLOCK OR THE 4100 BLOCK OF 18 FREDERICK ROAD;
- 19 **[**(1)**] (2)** from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. in the area specified in the Park Heights 20 Master Plan adopted by the City in 2006; and
- [(2)] (3) from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day in all other locations in the City.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
