2 Environment – Marine Contractors Licensing Board – Authority, Program 3 Evaluation, and Termination

4 FOR the purpose of establishing that the Marine Contractors Licensing Board is subject to 5 the Maryland Program Evaluation Act; establishing that the Board is a unit in the 6 Department of the Environment; authorizing the Board, by regulation, to establish 7 certain license categories; requiring the Board to include a certain license category 8 on each license issued by the Board; clarifying that an individual or entity is 9 prohibited from conducting, or attempting or offering to conduct, certain marine 10 contractor services unless licensed by the Board to perform the services; providing for the termination of the Board and certain provisions of law relating to the Board 11 12 after a certain date; altering the definition of a certain term; and generally relating to the Marine Contractors Licensing Board. 13



"Licensed marine contractor" means an individual or entity that has received 15 a license from the Board to perform marine contractor services. 16 17 (f) "Marine contractor services" (1) means construction, installation, alteration, repair, or salvage activities located in, on, [over,] or under State or 18 19 private tidal wetlands. 20 "Marine contractor services" includes: (2)21(i) Dredging and filling; 22 The construction, demolition, installation, alteration, repair, or (ii) salvage of structures, including boathouses, boat or other personal watercraft lifts or 23 ramps, slips, docks, floating platforms, moorings, piers, pier access structures, pilings, 2425wetland observation platforms, wetland walkways, and wharfs; and 26 The construction, demolition, installation, alteration, repair, or (iii) 27salvage of stabilization and erosion control measures, including revetments, breakwaters, 28bulkheads, groins, jetties, stone sills, marsh establishments, and beach nourishment or

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other similar projects.
