A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Motor Vehicle Registration – Exception for Golf Carts – Hoopers Island

3 FOR the purpose of creating an exception from motor vehicle registration requirements 4 under certain circumstances for golf carts on Upper or Middle Hoopers Island; $\mathbf{5}$ providing that a person who operates a golf cart on a highway on Upper or Middle 6 Hoopers Island may operate the golf cart only on certain roads at certain times and 7 only if the golf cart is equipped with certain lighting devices; requiring a person who 8 operates a golf cart on a highway on Upper or Middle Hoopers Island to keep as far 9 to the right as feasible and possess a valid driver's license; authorizing the County 10 Council of Dorchester County to designate highways on which a person may operate 11 a golf cart on Upper or Middle Hoopers Island; and generally relating to an exception 12to motor vehicle registration requirements for golf carts on Upper or Middle Hoopers 13Island.
