- 18 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT USE ANY CONTRIBUTOR INFORMATION FROM ANY 19 REPORT OR STATEMENT REQUIRED UNDER THIS TITLE FOR COMMERCIAL 20 SOLICITATION PURPOSES.
- (B) A PERSON MAY NOT PUBLISH ANY CONTRIBUTOR INFORMATION FROM
   ANY REPORT OR STATEMENT REQUIRED UNDER THIS TITLE IN NEWSPAPERS,
   MAGAZINES, BOOKS, OR OTHER SIMILAR MEDIA FOR THE PURPOSE OF FACILITATING
   COMMERCIAL SOLICITATION.
