- 5 (b) (1) An appeal [pursuant to] UNDER this section shall be taken by filing [an order for] A NOTICE OF appeal with the register of wills within 30 days after the date of the final judgment from which the appeal is taken.
- 8 (2) Within [30] **60** days [thereafter] **AFTER THE FILING OF A NOTICE OF**9 **APPEAL UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION,** the register of wills shall
 10 transmit all pleadings and orders of the proceedings to the court to which the appeal is
 11 taken, unless the orphans' court from which the appeal is taken extends the time for
 12 transmitting these pleadings and orders.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any order for an appeal filed before the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 October 1, 2020.
