A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Board of Education – Voting**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the number of affirmative votes of members of the Anne
4 Arundel County Board of Education required for the approval of any action by the
5 county board; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the
6 Anne Arundel County Board of Education.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

9 Section 3–2A–06
10 Annotated Code of Maryland
11 (2018 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Education**

15 3–2A–06.

16 The affirmative vote of at least [five] **SIX** members of the county board is required
17 for the approval of any action.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
19 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has
20 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three–fifths of all the members elected to
21 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is
22 enacted.
