2 **Anne Arundel County Board of Education – Annual Meeting – ~~Date~~ and Election**
3 **of Officers**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Anne Arundel County Board of Education to elect a
5 president and vice president from among its elected members at its annual meeting;
6 establishing the term of the president and vice president; providing that an
7 individual who fills a certain vacancy may be elected to serve as president or vice
8 president; altering the date on which the ~~Anne Arundel County Board of Education~~
9 county board is required to hold its annual meeting; and generally relating to the
10 annual meeting and officers of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education.

4 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
5 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

6 **Article – Education**

7 **3–2A–06.1.**

8 **(A) AT ITS ANNUAL MEETING, THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL ELECT A**
9 **PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT FROM AMONG ITS ELECTED MEMBERS.**

10 **(B) THE PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT SHALL SERVE A TERM OF 1 YEAR.**

11 **(C) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO FILLS A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF AN ELECTED**
12 **MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD UNDER § 3–2A–04 OF THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE**
13 **ELECTED TO SERVE AS PRESIDENT OR VICE PRESIDENT.**

15 (a) Each county board shall hold an annual meeting on or as near as possible to
16 the second Tuesday in July, except that:

17 (1) In Allegany County, the annual meeting shall be held on the second
18 Tuesday in January;

19 **(2) IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, THE ANNUAL MEETING SHALL BE**
20 **HELD ON OR AS NEAR AS POSSIBLE TO THE FIRST WEDNESDAY IN DECEMBER;**

21 **[(2)] (3)** In Montgomery County, the annual meeting shall be held on or
22 before January 10;

23 **[(3)] (4)** In Prince George’s County, the annual meeting shall be held on
24 the first Monday in December;

25 **[(4)] (5)** In St. Mary’s County, the annual meeting shall be held following
26 the first Monday in December; and

27 **[(5)] (6)** In Washington County, the annual meeting shall be held in
28 December, on or before the 16th day.

29 (c) Except as provided in Title 3 of this article, each county board, at its annual
30 meeting, shall elect a president and a vice president from among its members by means of
31 an individually recorded vote.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
2 1, 2020.
