FOR the purpose of requiring the Anne Arundel County Board of Education to elect a
president and vice president from among its elected members at its annual meeting;
establishing the term of the president and vice president; providing that an
individual who fills a certain vacancy may be elected to serve as president or vice
president; altering the date on which the Anne Arundel County Board of Education
county board is required to hold its annual meeting; and generally relating to the
annual meeting and officers of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education.
