A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Economic Development – Maryland Technology Development**
3 **Corporation – Chief Executive Officer**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the title of the Executive Director of the Maryland Technology
5 Development Corporation to be the Chief Executive Officer of the Corporation;
6 making conforming changes; authorizing the publisher of the Annotated Code of
7 Maryland to make certain changes in a certain manner; and generally relating to the
8 Maryland Technology Development Corporation.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Economic Development

(a) (1) (i) The Commission consists of:

B. the **CHIEF** Executive [Director] **OFFICER** of the
Maryland Technology Development Corporation, or the **CHIEF** Executive [Director's]

The Authority consists of:

(1) the **CHIEF** Executive [Director] **OFFICER** of the Maryland Technology
Development Corporation, or the **CHIEF** Executive [Director's] **OFFICER'S** designee;

10–402.

(a) There is a Maryland Technology Development Corporation.

10–404.

(a) The Corporation shall employ [an] **A CHIEF** Executive [Director] **OFFICER**.

(b) The **CHIEF** Executive [Director] **OFFICER** shall have experience with and
possess qualifications relevant to the activities and purposes of the Corporation.

10–405.

(a) The Attorney General is the legal advisor to the Corporation.

(b) (3) (i) The general counsel to the Corporation shall:

1. advise the **CHIEF** Executive [Director] **OFFICER**, Board
of Directors, and any other official of the Corporation as requested by the Corporation;

2. supervise the other assistant Attorneys General assigned

1 to the Corporation; and

2 3. perform for the Corporation other duties the Attorney
3 General assigns.

5 (a) There is a Coordinating Emerging Nanobiotechnology Research in Maryland
6 Fund in the Corporation.

7 (d) The **CHIEF** Executive [Director] **OFFICER** of the Corporation, or the **CHIEF**
8 Executive [Director's] **OFFICER'S** designee, shall administer the Fund in accordance with
9 this part and other applicable law.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the publisher of the
26 Annotated Code of Maryland, in consultation with and subject to the approval of the
27 Department of Legislative Services, shall correct, with no further action required by the
28 General Assembly, cross-references and terminology rendered incorrect by this Act. The
29 publisher shall adequately describe any correction made in an editor's note following the
30 section affected.

1 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 2020.
