1 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a person may not hunt 2 any game bird or mammal on Sundays.

3 (2) The following persons may hunt the specified game birds and mammals4 on Sundays:

5 (iv) Subject to the provisions of § 10–411 of this subtitle, in Calvert, 6 Caroline, Carroll, Charles, Harford, Queen Anne's, Somerset, [Talbot,] Wicomico, and 7 Worcester counties, a person hunting deer on private property with a bow and arrow or 8 crossbow during open season on the last three Sundays in October and the second Sunday 9 in November;

(12) (i) This paragraph applies only in Dorchester County.

(ii) Subject to §§ 10–411 and 10–415 of this subtitle, the Department
 may allow a person to hunt deer on private property on the second and third Sunday of the
 deer firearms season.

14 (iii) [Subject to §§ 10–411 and 10–415 of this subtitle, the 15 Department may allow a person to hunt deer on private property on a Sunday during the 16 bow hunting season from the first Sunday in October through the second Sunday in 17 January the following year, inclusive.

18 (iv)] Subject to §§ 10–411 and 10–415 of this subtitle, the Department 19 may allow a person to hunt deer on private property on a Sunday during the deer muzzle 20 loader season.

21(15) (I)THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES ONLY IN DORCHESTER COUNTY22AND TALBOT COUNTY.

(II) SUBJECT TO §§ 10–411 AND 10–415 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE DEPARTMENT MAY ALLOW A PERSON TO HUNT DEER ON PRIVATE PROPERTY ON A SUNDAY DURING THE BOW HUNTING SEASON FROM THE FIRST SUNDAY IN OCTOBER THROUGH THE SECOND SUNDAY IN JANUARY THE FOLLOWING YEAR, INCLUSIVE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
 1, 2020.
