- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 23 (u) (3) (ii) After the first fiscal year of operations, the exclusion specified in
- 24 subparagraph (i) of this paragraph may not exceed a percentage established by the
- 25 Commission by regulation of the proceeds received from video lottery terminals and table

- 6 (2) (C)(2) of this subtitle shall be retained by the licensee.

- 8 (a) Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c) of this section and § 9–1A–26(a)(3) of this subtitle, on a properly approved transmittal prepared by the 10 Commission, the Comptroller shall pay the following amounts from the proceeds of video

- 13 Worcester County if the video lottery operation licensee assumes ownership or the right to

- 16 (b) (1) Beginning July 1, 2013, for a video lottery facility in Worcester County
 17 with less than 1,000 video lottery terminals, the percentage in subsection (a)(2) of this
 18 section is equal to 43% provided that each year an amount equivalent to 2.5% of the
- 19 proceeds from video lottery terminals at the video lottery facility is spent on capital
- 20 improvements at the video lottery facility.

- 9 AND (III) of this item, 0.75% to the Small, Minority, and Women-Owned Businesses
- 10 Account established under § 5–1501 of the Economic Development Article;
- 11 [2.] (II) for fiscal year 2018, 0.75% to the General Fund to
- 12 pay a portion of the costs of the grants provided under Chapters 6 and 607 of the Acts of
- 13 the General Assembly of 2017; and
- 14 [3.] (III) for fiscal years 2019 and 2020, 0.75% to the
- 15 Education Trust Fund established under § 9–1A–30 of this subtitle; and
- 16 [(vi)] (6) the remainder to the Education Trust Fund established
- 17 under § 9–1A–30 of this subtitle.
- 18 [(2) After the first 10 years of operations at a video lottery facility in
- 19 Allegany County, the proceeds generated at the facility in Allegany County shall be
- 20 allocated as provided in subsections (a) and (b) of this section.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
- 22 1, 2020.
