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2 Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Operator License Holder - 3 Establishment Operations

- FOR the purpose of altering certain provisions relating to resident applicants of certain licensed alcoholic beverages establishments in Harford County; requiring a license holder who is an operator of a certain licensed establishment to have certain ownership interests in certain entities; requiring the <u>operator</u> license holder to serve as a manager or supervisor of the establishment and to be physically present on the premises for a certain time; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses and operation in Harford County.

Article - Alcoholic Beverages 1 2 22-102.3 This title applies only in Harford County. 22-1703.4 The Board shall transfer a license that is issued for use in a business if: 5 (a) 6 (1) the business is sold to a different owner; and 7 **(2)** the new owner qualifies as a license holder. 8 This subsection applies to the [resident applicant] LICENSE HOLDER (b) (1) 9 WHO IS AN OPERATOR of a licensed establishment [for which a license was transferred after July 1, 1984, on behalf of a corporation, an unincorporated entity, or a limited 10 11 liability company. 12 (2)The OPERATOR [resident applicant] LICENSE HOLDER: if the transferred license is a Class A beer and wine license 13 (i) 1. or a Class A-1 or Class A-2 beer, wine, and liquor license, shall own at least 25% of the 14 15 total corporation, unincorporated entity, or limited liability company; OR 16 if the transferred license is any type of license other than 17 one specified in item 1 or 3 of this item, shall own at least 10% of the total business; or 18 for a Class C-1. Class C-2. or Class C-3 license, may own any amount or no amount of the total corporation, unincorporated entity, or limited liability 19 20 company; 21 shall serve as manager or supervisor; and (ii) 22shall be physically present on the premises a substantial amount (iii) 23 of time on a daily basis. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 24251, 2020.
